New Business

Alcohol Campaign: Chestnut has been posting alcohol campaign posters around Mason County. The alcohol campaign newsletter is also available on the Havana School District website. Chestnut is compiling the results from the process evaluation survey which was conducted from January to the beginning of March and will begin to roll out the marketing evaluation survey in the coming weeks.

Youth Prevention Education: Tyler and Dominic at Chestnut are currently teaching the Too Good for Drugs curriculum to 6th and 7th graders at Lincoln Junior High School and 7th graders at Midwest Central Middle School. Teaching should be wrapped up by the end of April.

Resource Directory: Tyler and Dominic have been continually updating both the Logan and Mason County resource directories over the past few weeks. The resource directories are being modified to make it easier to navigate each website.

Prom Positive Messaging: Prom at Havana High School is taking place on Saturday, April 19th, 2025. Grace from Chestnut presented posters to choose from to post around the high school for prom positive messaging. The group of HAPT decided that the 1st and 3rd posters presented would be appropriate to use for prom. Chestnut will print out around 10 small posters and 5 large posters of each design to put up around the school.

Sticker Shock: Debbie will reach out with FCA and Interact Club at Havana High School to see if any students are interested in joining. Wednesday, April 23rd, is the tentative date for the Sticker Shock event. Debbie will also call businesses beforehand to get their permission for HAPT to perform Sticker Shock at their business locations.

Conversation Starters: The Chatterboxes/5-Star Challenges are ready for distribution around Havana. They will be distributed at the library, the park district, youth groups at churches, local restaurants, and local tabletop game stores.

Drug Take Back: In coordination with Mason County Sheriff's Department, Chestnut will be in Mason County on Saturday, April 26th, 2025, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. The drop-off locations will be Mason City at the IGA parking lot from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m., the Lodge at Manito from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., and finally the Old Oney's parking lot in Havana from 1 p.m. to 2 p.m.

Recruitment Ideas: Chestnut presented the Coalition Sectors Sheet that has also been presented at the March Logan County SUPS Coalition meeting. HAPT members brainstormed the different people/organizations that would fill the role of each sector of a coalition. HAPT members will look at this list outside of the meeting and provide feedback at May's meeting.
