Impacted youth books have been distributed in Logan and Mason County libraries to help bring awareness. The goal is to provide more books to put in school libraries and other non-profits.

Care kits (backpacks with hygiene products and school supplies) have been distributed. They are also looking into getting smaller backpacks for younger students. They also offer scholarships and provide school closets.

Student leaders- Olivia said that Interact put the ribbons on the trees during Red Ribbon Week.

Feedback on C3 Mentoring- Xavier said that students liked the January cocoa and February pizza activities.

Wind Grant for 2025- Carl moved to approve the wind grant application as presented. Nancy seconded. Motion carried.

C3 mentoring feedback- Everyone thought that Wednesday's gift affirmation went well. Laura Angotti had positive comments about CPAC. Eric said that 2nd semester mentoring will shift toward more familiar activities.
