Old Business:

DARE Graduation: Daryl stated that the DARE graduation had a great turnout in attendance for both parents/guardians and students.

New Business:

Alcohol Campaign: Chestnut is continuing to gather data for their parent process evaluation survey for their alcohol campaign. The next sporting event where surveys will be conducted in Havana will be on February 27th (Look at "Upcoming Dates" for more info). Families can expect direct mailers to be sent out by both Havana Jr. High School and Havana High School by the middle to end of February.

Youth Prevention Education: Tyler and Dominic are over halfway done teaching Midwest Central Middle School's 6th grade and will go straight into teaching the 7th grade by the middle of February. They are expected to be finished teaching at Midwest Central by the middle of March. Tyler and Dominic have also just begun teaching the 6th and 7th grade classes at Lincoln Jr. High School and are expected to finish teaching by the middle of April.

Resource Directory: Dominic and Grace will be revising and updating both Logan and Mason County's resource directories over the next few months. The plan is to make the resource directories more legitimate to the public. There is now a footnote attached at the end of each

page of both Logan and Mason County's directory to reflect that the websites are being updated consistently.

Conversation Starters: Chatterboxes have been created for HAPT to distribute to the community by the March meeting.

Recruitment Ideas: Daryl proposed the idea to contact the people linked to the HAPT email list in order to see if they are still committed to being a part of HAPT. The hope with this idea is to bring inactive members back to the group and get them involved in more of HAPT's future projects.
